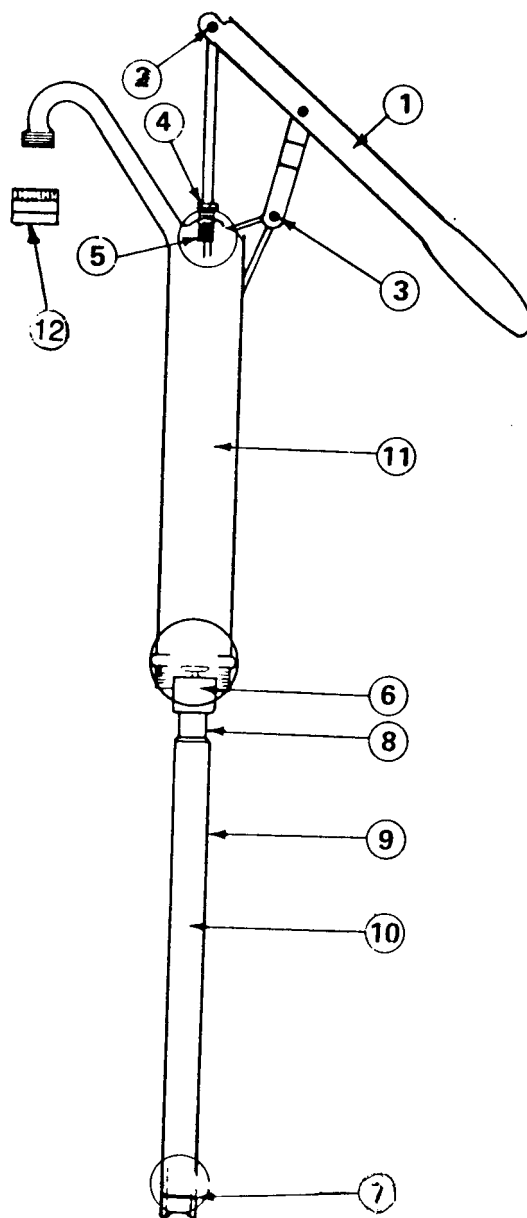


MODELS D-S AND D-S1 DRUM PUMPS

Assembly and Operating Instructions

1. Remove plunger rod pin from handle.
2. Line up holes in handle to plunger rod and insert plunger rod pin then insert cotter key.
3. Screw telescoping tube into threaded extension at base of pump. Tighten carefully with wrench.
4. Insert pumps assembly in drum bung and tighten by hand - do not use a wrench.
5. In using the pump the first time, it may be necessary to prime it by putting some of the liquid, which is to be pumped, into the nozzle.
6. It may be necessary to adjust the plunger rod packing nut (Ref. No. 4.) to prevent leakage around or relieve binding of the plunger rod. Tighten to stop leakage or loosen to prevent binding.
